SWIMMING POOL RULES

1. All patrons must pay daily fee or have season pass to enter.
2. Do not bring valuables to the pool. Not responsible for any stolen or lost items!
3. Shower before using pool and after using rest room.
4. No open cuts, sores, rash, infection or contagious diseases allowed in the pool area.
5. No diarrhea within the last 2 weeks. (cryptosporidium – State guidelines)
6. Proper swim wear required. Swimmers not potty trained must wear swim diaper. Cut off jean shorts are not allowed.
7. Children under 6 years old must be accompanied to the restroom.
8. Children 10 years old and under must have passed level 3 class in order to come to the pool without supervision of an adult that is 15 years or older or certified babysitter. Children must be within 5 feet at all times of an adult that is 15 years or older or certified babysitter.
9. Adult or babysitter must stay within arm reach of swimmers using any flotation device.
10. All swimmers under the age of 16 must pass a deep water swim test each season.
11. No one is allowed in deep end with lifejackets or parents, they must pass the test.
12. No running, horseplay, fighting or pushing people in.
13. No sitting or hanging on ladders and ropes.
14. No backwards entry, dives or flips from the side of the pool.
15. Diving board rules:
 - a. No recreational swimming is allowed in the diving board area.
 - b. Only one person on the board at a time, this includes climbing the ladder.
 - c. Enter the water straight in front of the board.
 - d. No "sit dives" or inward dives off the board.
 - e. No cart wheels off the board.
 - g. Only one bounce is allowed on the board.
 - g. Person in front of you should be to the side before you enter the water.
16. No food or gum on pool deck.
17. No standing on chairs and only one chair per person when pool is crowded.
18. No pets.
19. No smoking.
20. No one permitted in pool without lifeguard on duty.
21. All swimmers regardless of age are subject to benching or disciplinary actions.
22. Swearing or vulgar language is prohibited.
23. Glass of any form is not permitted within the confines of the pool area including bottles, ceramic dishes and other products that may shatter.
24. Flotation devices, beach balls, and toys are permitted in the pool area at the discretion of the Pool Manager and/or lifeguards. *Water guns or pistols are not permitted.* No such equipment is permitted in the deep end of the pool. On crowded days, lifeguards may prohibit all such items at their discretion.
25. Patrons should not engage in unnecessary conversation with the lifeguards, as their major responsibility is the surveillance of swimmers.
26. The discretion and authority of the lifeguards in maintaining a safe and enjoyable atmosphere is final. Disagreements may be taken up with the Pool Manager at a later time.
