Everyone in the Village votes at the Fire Station. Polls are open from 7am to 8pm. There will be two elections in 2021 and the dates and major offices listed below.

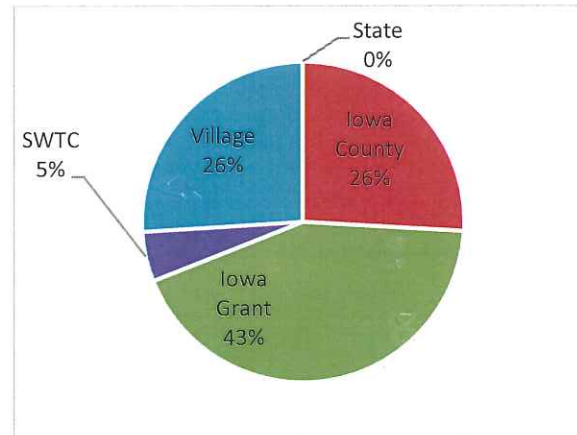
February 16 – Spring Primary

Your Tax Dollar



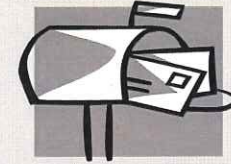
If you do NOT have a *lottery credit*, and this was your primary residence on January 1, 2020, please contact the office to receive the credit **BEFORE** you make payment!!

If the office is closed when you would like to make your payment, please place payments in the **drop box to the left of the front door.**

When paying in person, via the drobox or by mail include:

1. A check made out to Montfort Treasurer
2. The bottom third of your tax bill
3. A self- addressed stamped envelope for a receipt (if you need one).
4. Do not include dog license or utility fees on your tax check.

All garbage is to be placed curbside (not in gutter) for pick up. If you have a larger item call Town & Country at 608-375-5856 to make pick up arrangements. The Village dumpster is for Village use only. Call if questions.



Alternate Side Parking

November 1st to April 1st alternate side parking is in effect between midnight and 7:00am. The easiest way to remember is to follow the calendar. If today is an even day, park on the even side of the street this evening.



Burn Site

Only leaves, weeds or garden waste can go in the mulch pile. Brush and small branches only are allowed in the burn pile. Ashes are not allowed at the site. You must bag and put in your trash. When in doubt call public works. Reminder, no burning in the streets.



Christmas Tree Pick Up

Trees will be picked up on Mondays. Place tree curbside free of decorations and stand for pick up.



No ATVs in Parks

ATVs are not allowed in any Village park – go around.



Do Not Feed Stray Cats

Call public works to rehome or take to Grant County shelter.



Pursuant to Section 174.05(2) WI Statutes, ALL DOGS (more than 5 months of age) shall annually obtain a dog license and are required to have rabies vaccinations and dog licenses.

Licenses are obtained at the Village Office during normal business, through the mail or via the drop box. Remember to enclose a self-address stamped envelope so we can mail your license back to you. Proof of current rabies vaccination with vaccination and expiration dates are required to receive a license.

Licenses and Fees

If your dog is altered (spayed/neutered) the cost of a license is **\$5.00**. If your dog is unaltered the cost is **\$10.00**. All licenses are good from January 1 to December 31st of a calendar year.

Note: There is a \$10.00 late fee for any dog license issued after April 1.

Be responsible pet owners. Keep them on a leash and pick up after them when off your property.



Water, Sewer & Garbage Billing

Meters are read every month and will only be estimated in cases of inclement weather. Avoid paying a late fee by paying your bill on or before the due date. Please remember the drop box is available for you. Please consider receiving your bill by email. Share your email address to receive bills, alerts and newsletters from the Village. **Auto pay is now available.** Contact the Village Office or see website for more information.

In efforts to stop backups in your home and potential problems at the sewer plant, do not flush anything but toilet paper and human waste. Dispose of wipes and feminine products in the garbage.

Don't SINK Your Grease!

Keep these out of our District's sewer:

- GREASE AND FATS
- OILS
- DRESSINGS
- SAUCES
- FOOD SCRAPS
- GRAYIES

Instead:

- ✓ Make it a habit to wipe grease and food scraps off of dishes and pots and put them into your trash.
- ✓ Pour grease and oil into a container and, once cool, put it in your trash.
- ✓ Be aware that dish soap, cleaners, and hot water do not dissolve grease. They wear off in the sewer system and make a greasy mass.
- ✓ Restaurants are required to clean and maintain their grease traps or interceptors.

Grease congeals and sticks in the sewer system causing backups and overflows.

What is the Public Fire Protection Charge?

This is a charge that is required by State law, and regulated by the State of Wisconsin's Public Service Commission. This is a cost collected for the benefit of municipal water utilities for the express purpose of recovering the costs to supply proper volume & pressure for fighting fires.

How has Public Fire Protection been paid in the past?

The Village has been using property tax dollars to subsidize the utility at the rate of approximately \$72,818/ year for facilities in the Village of Montfort.

Why is this now going to show up as a fee on my Utility Bill?

The Public Service Commission increased the rate to \$92,022 beginning in 2021. The Village can no longer afford to subsidize the entire payment with the use of property taxes. Utility customers will now have to pay for a service that was previously subsidized by only the Village's property taxpayers.

Licenses are required in the Village of Montfort dogs five months of age and older. Licenses can be obtained from the Village Office at 102 E. Park Street, Monday thru Thursday from 8 AM to 4:30 PM. To apply by mail or drop box, complete the form below and enclose a copy of the PROOF of rabies certificate and a **self-addressed stamped envelope**.

According to Village Ordinance, there is a maximum limit of 3 dogs per household.

If you no longer have a dog or they have died, please let the Village Clerk know so we can remove them from our list.
