CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Meeting called to order at 6:40 pm by President Chuck Piper. PRESENT: Chuck Piper, Pat Raimer, Don Pluemer, Mindy Toay, Jonathon Schumacher and Mark Burton. Absent was Ryan Pilling. Also in attendance DPW Jason Sheire and Clerk Diana Klosterman.

Open Meeting Law compliance check: Confirmation that the Agenda was posted on December 3, 2024 to village website, Mills Market, Community Building & Montfort Post Office and published in the Dodgeville Chronicle on December 5th, 2024.

Chuck Piper opened the meeting to public comment. Resident Scott Fashun was present and asked to speak. He stated that prior to the water main replacement, he did not have any issues with water pressure. Since the replacement, he said that he has much lower water pressure and would like it fixed. He also felt that he was not given any information regarding the cost for the replacement.

Resident Don Hardy, who also had a replacement, was also present and stated that there were several meetings regarding this and that he has not have any issues with his water pressure. Chuck Piper, Board President, also said that he did not have any issues with his water pressure after the replacement either. There have not been any other water pressure complaints from any of the other residents. Public Works Director Jason Sheire said that he would check the pressure at the curbs top and at the house.

Payment options were discussed as the residents may make payment in full by November 1st, 2025 or they may have the assessment put on their taxes to be paid over a 5 year period at 3% interest. A motion was made by Jonathon Schumacher and seconded by Don Pluemer for approval of the assessments.
